
Dear Marshal,

Following your letter of 7 October 2019 which relates to our letter ref. REGIO.DDG.F.3/MD/aj/(2019)6059901, I would like to confirm the position of the European Commission as far as all investment priorities are concerned.

According to the Accession Treaty, any infrastructure investments involving the use of funds from the Community budget shall ensure that roads are constructed or upgraded to a load bearing capacity of 11.5 tonnes per axle. Therefore, both investment priorities in question - revitalisation as well as Community Led Local Development projects - have to comply with the load bearing capacity.
